The History of EPA regulated Recovery Centers - formerly "landfills"

- **National Recycling Strategy:** The journey began on November 15, 2021, when the Federal government embraced *Part One of a Series on Building a Circular Economy for All*. Reading the document may give you a more optimistic outlook on the future.
- **Solid Waste Infrastructure for Recycling Grant Program:** Pursuant to Congress' demands, on September 13, 2023 *\$100 million in grants have been allocated to enhance recycling efforts at EPA's Recovery Centers*.

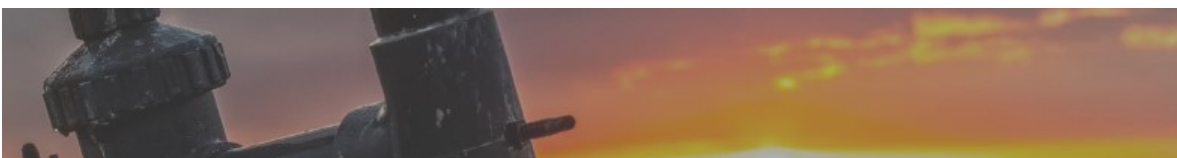
